The talented dim sum chefs then take diners on a journey of exquisitely handcrafted dim sum creations in both Sichuan and Cantonese styles, before the high tea wraps with a rice or noodle – a staple in Chinese cuisine – and a New Year Cake (年糕) that symbolises rising prosperity.

The sumptuous food menu is paired with a combination of three premium Chinese brews that will introduce you to the world of Chinese tea, which is full of depth and flavours. The Bi Tan Piao Xue (碧潭飘雪) is a delightful flower tea from the Xinjin county in Sichuan, boasting digestive and anti-ageing qualities. Its name is a reference to 'snowflakes' because it resembles snowflakes falling when infused. The Dong Ding Oolong (冻顶乌龙) on the other hand, is a tea from the Nantou county of Taiwan, with low tannic content and hence suitable for those suffering from gastric problems.
